- 1.** Sanjiv Ranjan has been appointed as the next Ambassador of India to Colombia.
- 2.** Ministry of Coal signed a MoU with Ministry of Energy, the Republic of Poland to foster relations in the field of coal mining and clean coal technologies through the already established Joint Coal Working Group as well as research institutes and academia between the two countries.
- 3.** Veteran Marathi actor Ramesh Bhatkar passed away. He was 70.
