- 1) 8th meeting of India – China Joint Working Group on Counter-terrorism was held in Beijing.
- 2) Vijay Singh Chauhan has been appointed as the Ambassador of India to Burkina Faso.
- 3) Madhya Pradesh government will set up 1,000 'Gaushalas' or cow shelters in the state.
- 4) The 12th edition of Aero India 2019 will be held at Yelahanka Air Force Station in Bengaluru from February 20 to 24.
- 5) Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated National Salt Satyagraha Memorial to the nation at Dandi village, situated in South Gujarat.
- 6) Dara Dotiwala, one of the on-field umpires in the historical Test between India and Australia in Chennai in September 1986, passed away recently. He was 85.
- 7) Union Finance and Railways Minister Piyush Goyal have been awarded the fourth Carnot prize for his work in sustainable energy solutions.
