- 1) India's latest communication satellite GSAT-31 was successfully launched by European launch services provider Arianespace's rocket from French Guiana.
- 2) The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a total penalty of Rs 2.2 crore on private sector lender Axis Bank in two separate cases. A penalty of Rs 2 crore has also been imposed on UCO Bank and Rs 1 crore on Syndicate Bank for violation of norms.
- 3) A Renowned Novelist of Iraq, Alaa Mashzoub has passed away recently. He was 51.
- 4) Senior IPS officer A P Maheshwari has been appointed as Special Secretary (Internal Security) in the Home Ministry.
- 5) Smriti Mandhana has become the number 1 in the latest ICC women's ODI rankings.
- 6) Anjali Saraogi has won the IDBI Federal Life Insurance Kolkata Marathon.
